The challenge is an initiative promoted by Daikin Industries and incMTY.

The Terms & Conditions that each participant adheres to are outlined below:

1. Participants who, for any reason, are unable to continue in the competition must notify their withdrawal so that appropriate measures can be taken. By participating, the participant agrees to the terms and conditions of the call.
2. Any claims regarding the results obtained by the teams and their classification, as well as any other matters related to the development of the competition, will be resolved definitively by the Evaluation Committee.
3. The organizing institutions reserve the right to disqualify any team if any irregularity is detected before or during the competition. For the project registration process, the registration form must be completed in full and with accurate information.
4. The information of each project will be used exclusively for the purposes of the program (evaluation and monitoring process); no person outside the program will have access to such information.
5. The ownership and authorship of the projects remain the exclusive property of the creators (project founders); the program does not request participation or any other benefit from them.
6. During the execution of the program, DAIKIN collaborators and staff will participate as mentors for the projects in various areas—such as commercial, marketing, business, among others—on the basis of open innovation and shared knowledge. However, if, as a result of the participation of a DAIKIN collaborator or staff member as a mentor, there is an identifiable contribution or technical intervention of a novel or inventive nature that generates the expectation of certain industrial property rights such as inventions, industrial designs, or utility models, and if it is of interest for protection by DAIKIN, the parties shall inform and agree with the participant, by mutual consent and in fairness, prior to continuing with the project and the program, on the terms of such co-ownership through the corresponding legal instrument, including ownership percentages, economic and exploitation rights, among others, with the understanding that the participant shall always have a share in ownership, economic participation, and exploitation rights. DAIKIN agrees that if it does not carry out the above in a timely manner and under the established process, or fails to do so with the participant's knowledge, it may not later claim any title or interest in any Intellectual Property rights resulting from the participation of its personnel or collaborators.
7. Participants may not submit projects related to activities prohibited under this call, such as: sex, pornography, criminal activities, gambling, betting, adult entertainment, casinos, or any type of transaction that violates national Mexican laws or regulations.
8. Each participant's data and information about their startup will be considered confidential. No other participant will have access to this information.
9. The organizing committee of the program may modify the rules as many times as necessary to clarify, improve, or expand the terms and conditions, with due public notice through appropriate means.
